If you would like to nominate someone else, you may wish to complete the form on their behalf or pass this information pack to him or her to complete. Alternatively, you can contact the Commission's office and we will send a pack direct to your nominee. If you complete the form, the declaration must be signed by the nominee so that we have their confirmation that the form is factually correct and that they consent to further necessary enquiries being made by the Commission.

The nomination and assessment process is a continuous one, with small numbers of recommendations being made at regular intervals. The Commission therefore welcomes nominations at any time.
