You requested:

A copy of all the documentation you have been instructed to disclose by the ICO in their decision notice IC-259838-W8R0.

Your request has been dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act) and following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that HOLAC does hold the information you requested.

As part of our commitments to being open and transparent, HOLAC publishes all information released via Freedom of Information requests on our website. Generally, the Commissioner cannot make a decision unless you have exhausted the complaints procedure provided by HOLAC.
